The contract recipient, the Sonoma County Community Development Commission (SCCDC), decided they were no longer interested in continuing this project as there were challenges locating and identifying youth served in this project. Thus, this funding was available as reallocated funding through a voluntary project elimination. SCCDC attempted to transfer the grant to the CoC's main youth service provider, however, they were not interested in taking on the grant. CoC Collaborative Applicant staff were notified of this on August 24, 2023.


